

## Waverly Girl's, Parent Suggestions

**(Parent(s) please sign below and have you player turn in form to their coach)**

As coaches, we ask for support from you to assist us in providing a positive soccer experience.

1. If you develop concerns about anything happening on the team, we ask that you contact us as soon as possible so we can discuss it privately and work together to develop a solution. ( 24 HOUR RULE: give at least 24 hours to think about the problem if it still an issue then please bring it to our attention)
2. We ask you that you help us encourage your child to honor her commitment to the team by requiring that she be on time and attend every practice, attend every game, and complete the entire season. (This applies even if she becomes injured)
3. Refuse to support a bad attitude! Your student's attitude will directly impact her playing time and the amount of fun she chooses to have this season. Even if she does not like something that is happening, it is still unacceptable to have a bad attitude or talk back to the coach.
4. **PLEASE, PLEASE, PLEASE**- Attend your child's games. They will never tell you how much it means to them, but believe me – IT DOES.
5. Watch your words. Even though they are teenagers, your child will deep-down wish to please you. Win or Lose, try to find something positive to say. On the sidelines, cheer LOUD for positive things, and bite your tongue during negative. That said, get rowdy and HAVE FUN!- there is nothing more inspirational to a team than loud, POSITIVE fans. GO WARRIORS!
6. Sportsmanship Above All! High school sports are a big part of American schools because of the lessons they teach students that will impact their whole lives. Playing by the rules, respecting the referees even if they are wrong, learning to accept that even though your coach is an idiot they are still the coach, learning that the team is more important than yourself, and finding greatness in unexpected places is what it is all about. Challenge your student to be excellent, and celebrate them when they are!
